Much like the paper version of Safeguard's Compatibility Guide [Software and Product Reports – DSC830851] CMS offers an electronic Compatibility Guide to help you quickly locate:

- → Base Negative numbers
- → Product Prefixes
- → Competitor Forms translations
- → Software Product Searches.

The two most common uses are the *Competitor Product Search* and *Software Product Search*.




Competitor Product Search


Competitor Product Search

Follow the instructions below to understand the use of this section:

Step	Action
1	Navigate to the Compatibility Guide from the File menu in CMS and press ENTER .
2	Click the Competitor Product Search link.
3	In the Competitor field, click the drop-down arrow to select the Competitor's name. [e.g. ENNIS]. Using the mouse, highlight the desired option to select it.
4	In the Competitor Product For field, use the mouse to scroll through the option and click on the desired form number with your mouse. [e.g. 430534]
5	In the Compatible Safeguard Products box, the following appears: COMPATIBLE SAFEGUARD PRODUCTS BASE NEGIADV APPLICATION PREFIX 93MS00009 PROD INU. CF ISGS957 93MS00009 PROD INU. 



Follow the instructions below to understand the use of this section:

Step	Action
1	Navigate to the Compatibility Guide from the File menu in CMS and press ENTER .
2	Click the Software Product Search link.
3	In the Software field, use the mouse to scroll through the list. [Software is listed alphabetically]. Using the mouse, highlight the desired option to select it.
4	A list of options will appear, depending on which software was selected, the list varies: BASE PRODUCT PREFIX

	 Base Neg/Adv – This is the layout code used for the Design forms Application – This tells you what type of form it is. [e.g. P/R CHECK, CF = Payroll Check, Continuous Feed] Product Prefix – This is the beginning of the product code used to order this product.





4	Show Base/Neg, cont.
	> Application - Product Description
	Size – the size of the check or form
	Perf – perforation dimensions/placement
	Special Code – Notes items like; Voucher Top (VT), Voucher Bottom (VB), and No Voucher (NO VOUCH).
	Printer – the type of printer this check or form uses.
	Color # Parts box – shows the color options and how many parts are available
	Competitors Products – shows a list of all the competitors that manufacture this check or form
	> Prefix – shows a list of available prefixes for this check or form
	 Software – shows a list of software programs that utilize this check or form
	 Additional Products – shows a list of additional items the
	customer might need [e.g. envelopes that match the form]

	 Go to Addtnl - When accessing the Compatibility Guide from the Order screen, displays the product file at the position of the highlighted product code in the Additional Products box. NOT available from the File Menu screen Next - takes you to the next one in the list Previous - takes you to the previous one in the list Search - enables you search by a base neg number Exit - allows you to exit this screen
	Print – allows you to print the information on the screen


Software Compatibility List

Introduction

The Software Compatibility List displays all the Safeguard products compatible with any software packages in the Compatibility Guide.

Use this option to create a report that will show all of the check or forms prefixes, base negative numbers, and product descriptions for a specific software application.

Software Compatibility List

Follow the instructions below to understand the use of this section:

-	
Step	Action
1	Navigate to the Compatibility Guide from the File menu in CMS and press ENTER .
2	Click the Software Compatibility List link.
3	Scroll through the available list, using the mouse highlight the desired option and press ENTER.
	NOTE: The Software selected list will now be populated.
4	In the Designation box, select the option for output
	Screen Disk
	 Printer – sends the report direct to the printer Screen – allows you to view the information on the screen prior to printing. Disk – allows you to export the information
	Click the Run button to continue.
5	If you selected Screen as the destination option, you will have additional choices when using the print preview function.
	Print Preview Id d
	Next, Previous, First, Last [arrow] buttons - allow you to move through a multiple page report.
	 Zoom drop-down – allows you to zoom in and out as needed.
	> Close button— when clicking on the door icon, the report closes
	Print button – allows you to send the report to the printer.
